## **Please Pray**

*Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.* 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

While we wait for the return of Christ, we are to be about Christ's work. One of the things this includes is praying. Jesus set for us an example of prayer—not only the Lord's Prayer but going off by himself to pray. We need to pray that our heart is right to accept Jesus who is coming again. We should also pray for each other, our neighbors, those who receive assistance from our church, our family, our friends, those who mourn, those who celebrate, those who are in war zones, those that are hungry and have no way to get food, the refugees, the homeless, the lonely, our church and many more that I have not named.

We should pray throughout the year. Our church attendance is not as high as we would like it to be. Some people believe that if we would stop our Facebook broadcast, people would come back to church. First, many of the people we reach on Facebook don't live locally, in fact, some don't live in this country. Second, statistics show that churches have not bounced back from COVID. Regardless of whether or not churches continued to meet in person during the pandemic, their attendance has not returned to pre-pandemic numbers.

As we start the new year, I would like to ask each of you to pause from your busy schedules at noon and pray for our church. Pausing at the same time will enable us to pray as though we were together. We are in a time of trying to revitalize our church. Nancy Boyd is talking to some of the old members, as well as some of the members who don't attend regularly, to see if they will come back. We are missing a generation or two of the children who grew up in this church as well as some of the people who feel the church has failed them in some way. If you know someone who has stopped coming to our church or who doesn't have a church home, tell them that they are always welcome here. It's not as important to us where they've been or why they haven't been coming as it is where they are going. We would like to share the journey with them. Please pray that Nancy's efforts and the efforts of all who try to get their families and friends to attend will bear good fruit.

Here is a sample prayer if you have trouble with praying for this: *Heavenly Father, we come before you today to ask for your guidance and blessings upon our church. We pray that you will help us to grow in faith and also in numbers so that we may better serve you and your people. We ask that you bless our leaders with wisdom and discernment, so that they may make the right decisions for our church. We pray that you will bless our members with a spirit of unity and love, so that we may work together to do your will. We ask that you bless our outreach efforts, so that we may reach those who have fallen away from the gathering together of the many and those that do not know of your love and bring them into your kingdom. We pray that you would bless our worship services, so that we may glorify you in all that we do. We ask all these things in the name of your son, Jesus Christ. Amen.*
